Thank you for interest in scheduling your observation hours with Weisman Children's Rehabilitation Hospital. Student opportunities are available for Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Speech Therapy, Therapeutic Recreation/ Child Life and Nutrition.

Hospital sites for Weisman Children's Rehab are located in Marlton, Pennsauken, Washington TWP and Northfield.

Student requirements:

- Must be an enrolled in college/university setting.
- Complete application forms
- Complete student observation orientation

Student observation is limited to a maximum of 20 hours, however 20 hours is not guaranteed.

All forms must be completed prior to orientation and will be collected at orientation. To schedule an orientation please email the volunteer manager at volunteerservices@weismanchildrens.com. Student observation will be scheduled once orientation is complete.

Please be aware that our facility follows Standard Precautions for infection control. Should you have any questions about Standard Precautions please contact Andrea Hoffman, RN, Infection Control Practitioner at 856-489-4520 ext. 205.

These are recommended guidelines that should be followed when completing observations in our hospital sites.

- Proof of Tuberculosis screening completion within the last year must be provided.
- Diagnosis/medical conditions are *confidential* and can not be divulged to anyone. Please do not ask staff or children information about diagnosis or why they are at Weisman Children's Rehabilitation Hospital.
- Dress Code-Business Casual is the preferred attire. Shirts must have sleeves. Shoes must be clean and have a closed toe. Pants/khakis are preferred. Shorts are not permitted.
- Please note that documentation that is required and is to be completed by hospital staff member(s) must be presented AT THE TIME OF OBSERVATION.
